

The organizing committee cordially invites you and looks forward for your bestowing presence to make this event grandiose.

Vanbandhu College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry was established on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2008 under Vanbandhu Kalyan Yojana and flagship of Navsari Agricultural University. Apart from imparting education and facilitating research in graduation, post graduation and Ph.D program, this college in South Gujarat also renders service to livestock farmers / owners and pet owners especially of tribal region.

Previously named 'Nag Mandal' in 1142 AD by the first dwellers Parsi Zoroastrians and situated on the banks of the river Purna, city of Navsari has a sunny weather from September to May, rainy from June to August with average maximum and minimum temperatures of 40°C and 18°C respectively. Besides being country's largest exporter of fruits viz. chikoo, mango etc., it is also known for sugarcane, floriculture, industries of Mafatlal, diamond business, agro & food processing, textiles, drugs & pharmaceuticals, mineral and marine products. Apart from being the birth place of eminent personalities like Dadabhai Naoroji and Jamsedji Tata; Navsari has many places to visit like Dandi (salt satyagrah), white sandy beach of Umbharat, Somnath Mahader Temple, Sayaji Vaibhar Public Library (having oldest religious manuscripts of Parsis) and Vansda national park. Black sand beach of Tithal in Valsad district and Daman (with Portugese architecture and untouched beaches) are 60 km and 85 km respectively from Navsari. The richness of pious cultural heritage and sanctimonius virtues of birth place of Mahatma Gandhi i.e. Gujarat can be gazed by the fact of prohibition of ligour in the state. The organizing committee would fervently ensure enriched and scientific environment for the conference apart from comfortable stay at Navsari.
