The National Veterinary Physiology Quiz competition for the students of B V Sc & A H is scheduled to be held with basic objective to highlight the importance of subject in profession as well as keep the students abreast of latest developments in the field by Society of Animal Physiologists of India (SAPI).

Modalities

The quiz shall be held at three levels.

- 1. College level:** All the Veterinary Colleges / Faculties shall hold a Veterinary Physiology quiz competition after open announcement and winning team shall qualify for zonal level competition. In this quiz competition all the students of B V Sc & A H shall be eligible and a team shall comprise of 2 (two) members. The SAPI life member / Representative / HOD of Veterinary Physiology of the concerned college or his representative shall organize this quiz as per format given below.
- 2. Zonal Level:** The country has been divided in to four zones and the colleges of different states falling in each zone shall be compete at zonal level and winner shall qualify for National Competition to be held simultaneously each year with National SAPI conference. The zonal level winner will get the prize in form of memento and certificate, besides books (if funds available with organizers permit). Zonal level competition shall be held at WBUAFS, Kolkata for Eastern Zone; CVAS, GBPUAT, Pantnagar for Northern Zone; Nagpur Veterinary College, Seminary Hills, Nagpur for Western Zone and NANIP, Bangalore for Sothern Zone for the year 2012.

The States falling in different zones are as follows:

- a) **North Zone:** Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Delhi.
- b) **East Zone :** Bihar, West Bengal, Assam, North Eastern States, Jharkhand, Orissa
- c) **West Zone :** Madhya Pradesh, Chattisgarh, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra,
- d) **South Zone :** Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Puducherry

3. National Level: The National level quiz competition shall be held in the forthcoming XXI Annual Conference / National Symposium of SAPI at Gujarat to be held on 6 – 8 November, 2012. The winner of zonal level competition from each zone shall qualify for National Veterinary Physiology quiz and winner will get the prize of Running trophy as well as replica of trophy with certificates.

4. All the teams are to bear the expenditure for participating in the Physiology Quiz upto zonal level, through University or college / faculty administration. The concerned authority of the institute may request to utilize the fund related to students' welfare and cultural activities.

5. The SAPI shall bear the expenses of the best team from each zone to attend the final event of quiz at venue of National Seminar of SAPI each year in form of travelling expenses, boarding and lodging etc.

6. The last date of organization of quiz at institute level is **07.09.2012** and at zonal level is **07.10.2012**.

7. The names of the selected team should be conveyed to the General Secretary, SAPI and the Coordinator of the Zonal Level Physiology quiz, SAPI of respective zone.

Format of Veterinary Physiology Quiz competition

The decisions of quiz master shall be final.

There will be five rounds of quiz and each round shall consist of minimum 2 set of questions.

Round 1 : From VPB – 111 and VPB – 121 syllabus

Round 2 : From VPB – 221 syllabus

Round 3 : Audio visual round from complete syllabus.

Round 4 : Clinical applications of Physiology and Misc.

Round 5 : Rapid fire round of 60 seconds duration consisting of yes/no answer without passing to next team. Right answer carrying 10 (ten) marks and wrong answer carrying (-) 5 (minus five).

Time to reply each question shall be 40 seconds and 20 seconds for pass questions.

Marks shall be half for pass questions.

Each answered question shall carry 10 marks, while answering passed question team will get 5 marks.

Organizer from respective colleges / zonal level can modify this basic guideline as per their suitability and convenience.
